

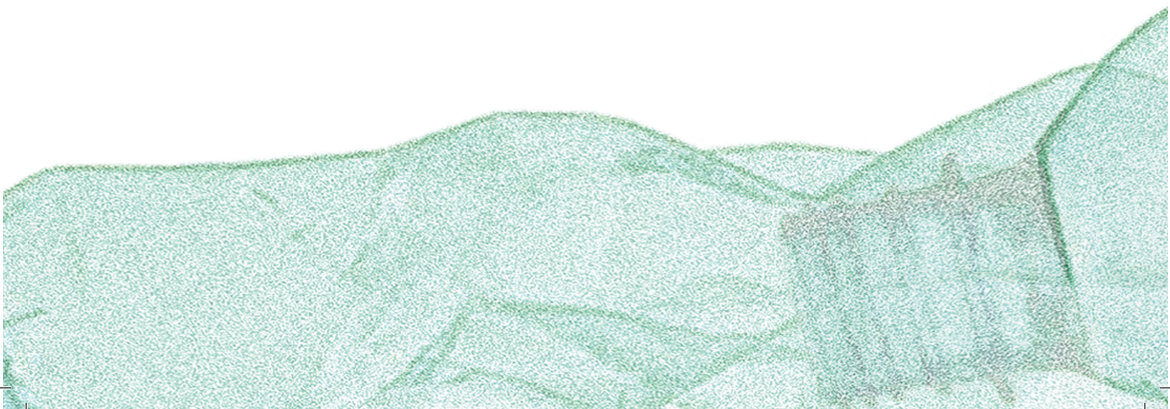

Have you ever noticed how much plastic packaging is hanging around in the bathroom? Bring the cleaned plastic waste to the creative workshop.

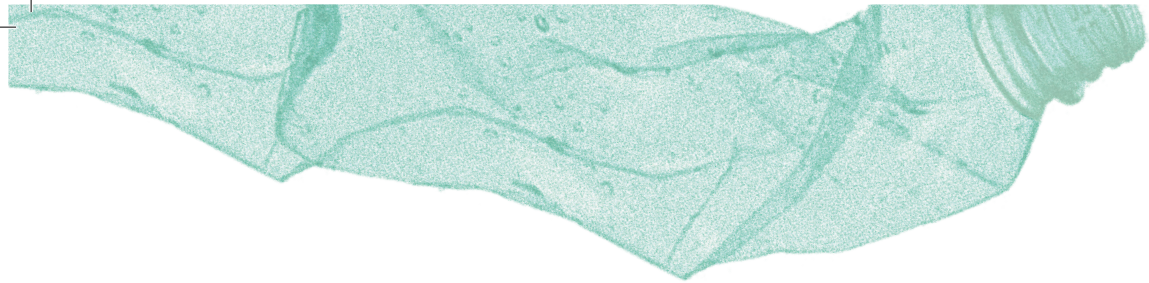


# CHALLENGE

Together with your class and teacher you will dive into a designing process. Look at the slides and be creative!

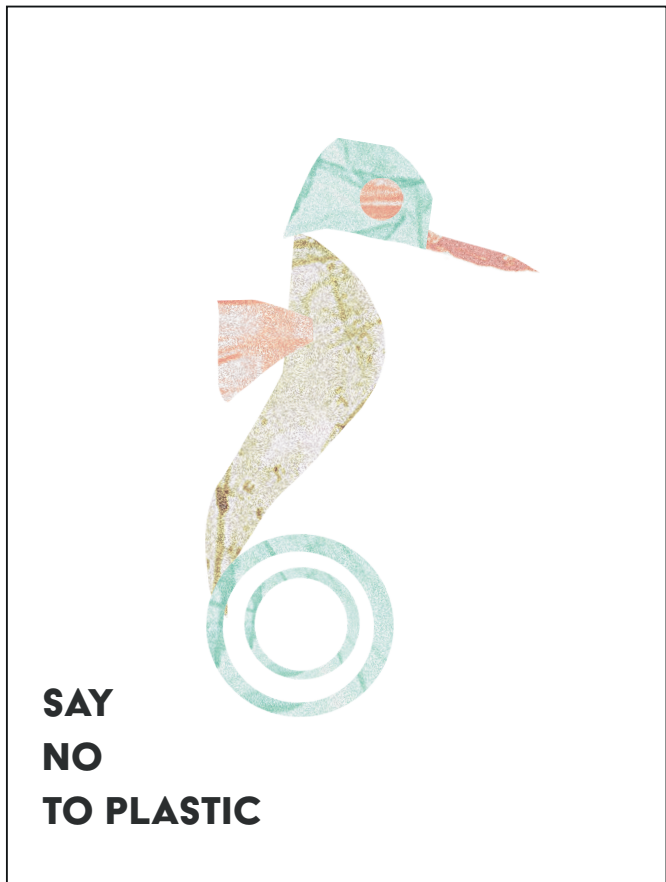


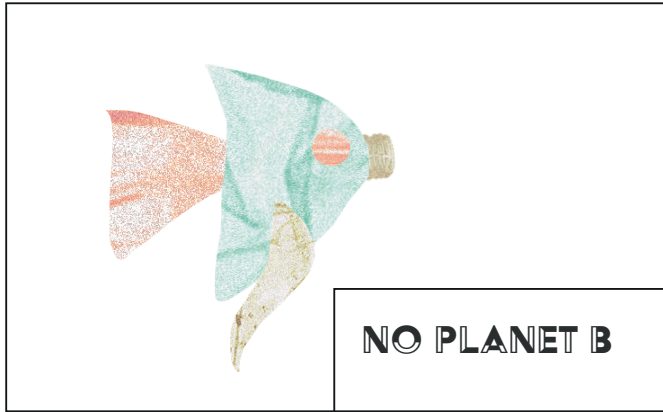




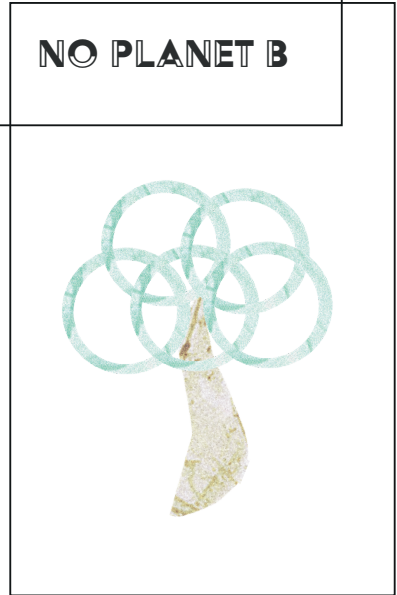
# AUDIENCE
